



Discontinuation of Order Entry on Order Management Terminal (OMT)

Overview

As of **September 17, 2018**, the Cboe Options Exchange (“Cboe Options”) plans to discontinue order entry functionality on Cboe Options Order Management Terminals (OMTs).

Details

Trading Permit Holders (TPHs) who operate on the Cboe Options trading floor currently have access to OMTs that are used for order entry and inquiries on orders that have been systematized into Cboe’s Order Handling System (OHS). Beginning September 17, 2018, the order entry function on OMTs will be discontinued. Note: order entry only (and not order inquiry) via OMTs are included in this change. Order entry into OHS via Pulse terminals or via Cboe’s FIX or CMI2 APIs are unaffected.
